Term Position Summary:

The successful applicant will be responsible for planning and instruction within the Saskatchewan Polytechnic Primary Care Paramedic (PCP) Program, including the theory, lab, and scenario requirements of the program, as assigned. Responsibilities include lesson planning, developing and delivering practical and theoretical instruction, evaluating student performance, and providing reports as required. Preparation time is included in the total approved days of the contract.

Main Responsibilities:

- ➤ Present theory, lab, and scenario components within the program, according to curriculum outlines, objectives, and resource materials provided by Saskatchewan Polytechnic
- > Teach, coach, and supervise PCP students in the classroom, lab, and practical framework settings
- Evaluate student progress and performance, following guidelines and standards set out by Saskatchewan Polytechnic, provide ongoing feedback accordingly, and communicate student updates to College and credit-granter staff accordingly
- > Act as a practicum liaison for PCP students and preceptors, in conjunction with Saskatchewan Polytechnic
- > Identify appropriate resource material (i.e., video, print material, web-based material, etc.) and work with Program Coordinator to secure the same
- Participate in program, campus, Saskatchewan Polytechnic, industry, and professional or other stakeholder activities/initiatives, as required

- Complete monthly reports, as required
- Arrange appropriate guest speakers, as required
- Participate in the College evaluation of the program by:
 - maintaining records and documents on the progress of the participants, and;
 - o maintaining other data required for evaluation purposes
- Deliver courses using a variety of teaching strategies, including technology enhanced teaching and learning strategies
