### **TERM POSITION SUMMARY:**

This position is primarily responsible for providing instruction of Adult Basic Education 12 as prescribed in course curricula by the Ministry of Education. Some Practical and Applied Arts 12 courses will be delivered as part of elective offerings. The position requires the instructor to deliver and monitor the Saskatchewan Youth Apprenticeship program.

### **JOB DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

#### 1. Main Responsibilities:

- Develop and submit to the supervisor, a course program outline in accordance with the curriculum guide for each course.
- To plan an adequate amount of preparation time prior to the program or course starting date.
- To develop and maintain an effective evaluation system, which monitors students' progress.
- Provide instruction to learners to develop their skills, abilities, knowledge in accordance with Suncrest College's Instructional Standards and the curriculum for each course.
- To ensure that sufficient resources are available throughout the program for instruction.
- To support students in areas of academic achievement, and in issues that affect regular attendance.
- To register students, administer challenges, track progress and report through MyATC for the Saskatchewan Youth Apprenticeship program.
- To effectively use technology in the classroom to enhance instruction and learning of the participants.
- To complete the necessary forms and reports.
- To be responsible for all activities which occur as part of the program.
- Ensure the work practices are consistent with College policies and procedures.
- Pursue professional development opportunities to keep current with employer and educational requirements.

- Other duties that are deemed necessary for the successful operation of the position, program or course as assigned by the supervisor.
- To effectively deliver (or be willing to learn in order to effectively deliver) curriculum via a blended curriculum or online delivery model, as required.

- Excellent instructional skills, including the use of technology in daily instruction.
- Demonstrated ability to work cooperatively with other staff in a team delivery approach to Adult Basic Education.
- Ability to operate A/V equipment, related computer equipment, and other technology used in the learning process such as video conferencing equipment, digital whiteboard technology, etc.
- Excellent computer skills, including the ability to use the internet for research, and the College email system.
- Ability to handle continuous intake and individualized instruction at rural locations.
- Ability to teach many curricula.
- Demonstrated personal responsibility for the performance necessary to achieve individual and / or team goals and objectives.
- Ability to research information and opportunities, make decisive decisions, and use deliberate strategies to influence, persuade or inspire others.
- Ability to adapt to changing circumstances.
- Demonstrated knowledge and experience with online curriculum delivery and its associated technologies is preferred.
