TERM POSITION SUMMARY:

This position is primarily responsible for providing instruction of Adult Basic Education 12 as prescribed in course curricula by the Ministry of Education, specifically: ELA A30, ELA B30, Native Studies 30, and a another elective (TBD). Classes will be delivered via synchronous virtual/online instruction.

JOB DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Main Responsibilities

- Develop and submit to the supervisor, a course program outline in accordance with the curriculum guide for each course.
- To plan an adequate amount of preparation time prior to the program or course starting date.
- To develop and maintain an effective evaluation system, which monitors students' progress.
- Provide instruction to learners to develop their skills, abilities, knowledge in accordance with Suncrest College's Instructional Standards and the curriculum for each course.
- To ensure that sufficient resources are available throughout the program for instruction.
- To support students in areas of academic achievement, and in issues that affect regular attendance.
- To effectively use technology in the classroom to enhance instruction and learning of the participants.
- To complete the necessary forms and reports.
- To be responsible for all activities which occur as part of the program.
- Ensure the work practices are consistent with College policies and procedures.
- Pursue professional development opportunities to keep current with employer and educational requirements.
- Other duties that are deemed necessary for the successful operation of the position, program or course as assigned by the supervisor.
- To effectively deliver (or be willing to learn in order to effectively deliver) curriculum via an online delivery model.
