POSITION SUMMARY:

This position is primarily responsible for the lab instruction of the Diagnostic Medical Sonography (Ultrasound) Advanced Diploma program. The course curriculum is directed by Red River College Polytech. The instructor must plan, teach, coach, evaluate and record learner progress and supervise learners in lab settings in accordance with the competency profile for Sonography Canada.

JOB DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Instruct, monitor and evaluate lab components of the program.
- Prepare and deliver lessons, assignments, lectures, labs and demonstrations.

- Practice good interpersonal skills and ensure a positive classroom environment.
- Control inventory and learner records as outlined by the College.
- Set up classroom facilities/labs.
- To effectively deliver (or be willing to learn in order to effectively deliver) curriculum via a blended curriculum or online delivery model, as required.

- Participate in the planning process to assist in determining College program plans.
- Develop and maintain community / agency partnerships.
- Assist in developing and implementing new programs.
