Grade 12 or successful completion of 15 post-secondary credits from a recognized institution, or Accuplacer. English Language Requirement, proficiency test or minimum of 24 credits from an accredited programs at an institution recognized by Saskatchewan Polytechnic, where English is the official language of instruction and examination.
